



2019 Calendar Quilt Challenge

Marking time, celebrating seasons.... The calendar can hearten or alarm us as it reveals the passage of time. It can build anticipation as we march toward a happy event, or remind us of times gone by. Changing seasons, changing times... Which month will inspire a quilt for you?

To be presented in Special Exhibits at the 2019 Mid-Atlantic Quilt Festival, each Challenge participant will create a quilt to represent a different month of the year.

Requirements — Calendar Challenge Quilts must have:

- **Title**
- **4" hanging sleeve** attached
(instructions: <http://www.bluemoonriver.com/assets/quiltsleeve.pdf>)
- Written **Artist Statement** that explains the techniques you used, the month you're representing, and what your choices mean to you. Also include pattern name and designer, if applicable, and quilter's name if you don't do the quilting yourself. (Please email Artist Statement to Heidi)
- Quilt size: 20"x20" Since we are representing the calendar, all quilts should be of uniform size for this challenge.
- Optional element: The name of the month on the front of the quilt — appliquéd, foundation-pieced, embroidered, etc.
