

Port bag instructions

Front:



Cut 2 7" x 7" squares

Back:



Cut 2 7" x 10" rectangles

Front: Place the 2 7" squares right sides together and sew using a $\frac{1}{2}$ " seam. Leave a 2.5" opening to turn inside out. Turn right side out and iron. Set aside.

Back: Place the 2 7" x 10" rectangles right sides together and sew using a $\frac{1}{2}$ " seam. Leave a 2.5" opening to turn inside out. Turn right side out and iron.

Stack the front on top of the back lining up the openings at the bottom.



Top stitch on 3 sides the two pieces together approximately $\frac{1}{8}$ " from the edge but leaving the top open making the pocket.

Fold the back edge down approximately 1" toward the back of the bag. Stitch across making a rod pocket for the string/tie.
