



Sunshine or Rain, WEATHER Rules

Definition: the state of the atmosphere with respect to heat or cold, wetness or dryness, calm or storm, clearness or cloudiness.

Challenge: Create a quilt with the theme “Weather” to be displayed in Special Exhibits at the 2023 Mid-Atlantic Quilt Festival

CHALLENGE REQUIREMENTS:

Size: All quilts MUST be 36” wide. You can choose to make it with a length anywhere between 36” and 48”.

Artist statement: Please write up a brief statement about your quilt. What was your inspiration? Why did you make the quilt the way you did? Be sure to include the title of your quilt, pattern name and designer (if you used a pattern), quilter’s name.

Your quilt must have a **4-inch hanging sleeve**.

Common element: Cloud. You must include at least one cloud somewhere on the front of your quilt. For example, it can be appliqué, fabric print, or quilting stitches.

Due Date: February 11, 2023. Bring your quilt to show at the guild meeting. Email your Artist statement to theboard@countrypiecemakers.org
