

Boo! Pillow Sham

(made to fit on a 14" pillow form)

What you need:

Pattern: "Boo!" by The Pattern Basket

Fabric:

- Ghost Body- ¼ yard or fat quarter
- Bow and pillow border- ¼ yard or fat quarter (If your fabric is directional, use fat quarter)
- Ghost face- small scraps (about 2" x 6" total)
- Background- ¼ yard of fat quarter
- Back of pillow- 1/3 yard
- 16" square muslin or other lining for quilting block
- 16" square cotton or poly/cotton blend batting (avoid puffy batting)



Sew in Velcro (two 2" pieces)

Sewing Machine in good working order

Basic sewing supplies including seam ripper, scissors/thread snips, ¼" machine presser foot and walking foot (recommended), fabric marking pencil, pins

Thread – neutral color piecing thread, thread to match background fabric for quilting, and thread to match the pillow backing fabric

Rotary cutter and ruler basic 6" x 24" and large square (15") if you have one
14" pillow (you do not need to bring this to class)

HOMEWORK BEFORE CLASS!

Page one of the pattern has cutting instructions for one block. To insure we have time to complete this project, please cut and label all piece before class***. In pattern, each piece is labeled by letter. I used masking tape to mark each piece (be sure to bring the extra fabric to make the rest of the pillow).

***Important Note: If your bow and pillow border fabric is directional, cut two side border strips 2 ½" x 14 ½" and two top/bottom border strips 2 ½" x 18 ½" from the fat quarter before you cut the bow pieces to make sure you have enough.
